Return to Gate Recycling Project



Auckland Council Provides Support to Iplex “Return to Gate” Recycling Scheme

Iplex is pleased to announce the roll-out of a recycling project in Auckland with the support of a grant from Auckland Council’s Waste Minimisation and Innovation fund. Over the coming months, Iplex will progressively place recycling collection stations on customer sites throughout Auckland to enable off-cuts of PVC and PE to be returned to its Palmerston North factory for re-processing.

The aim of the project is to pilot a scheme to divert PVC and PE pipe off-cuts from going to landfill. This project supports Auckland Council’s objective to achieve the regional goal of a 30% reduction of waste going to landfill by 2027. It also enhances Iplex’s ability to offer best environmental practise for the lifecycle of plastic pipe products, whereby ‘off-cuts’ or ‘end of life’ pipe may be returned to the factory for recycling into new pipe.
